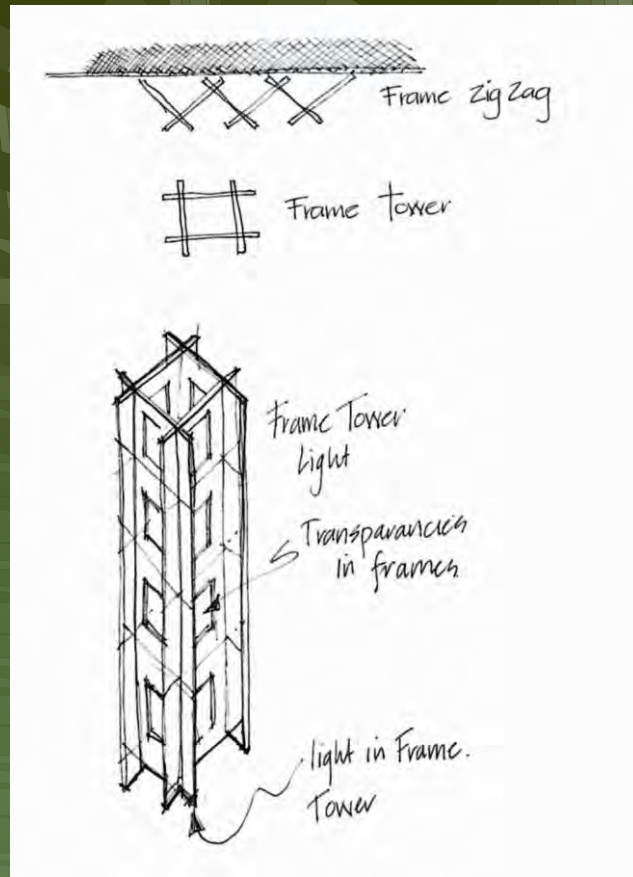
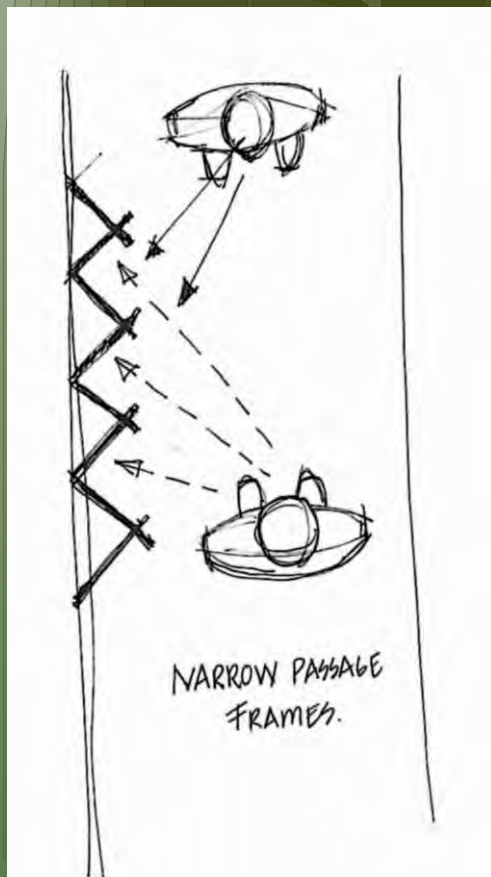


# Zig Zag

A frame that works in narrow passages.

One often finds people hang up photos in the typical long pages in South African homes. One cannot really see them unless you stop and face the frame.



Zig Zag is an interlocking frame system that positions the frames at 45 degrees to the wall so as you walk down the passage you see the photos and coming the other way, you see others

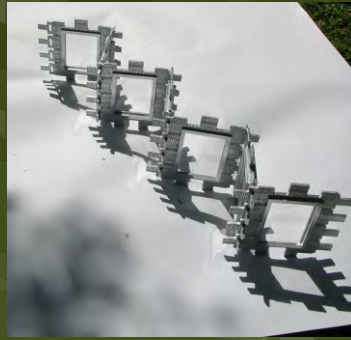
This kind of frame would work well on any wall that one cannot stand back from and view.

The interlocking frames could also be slotted together to form a freestanding structure/ tower for a table or mantelpiece

Transparencies can be put in the frames it could also become a lamp shade.

View from blue side

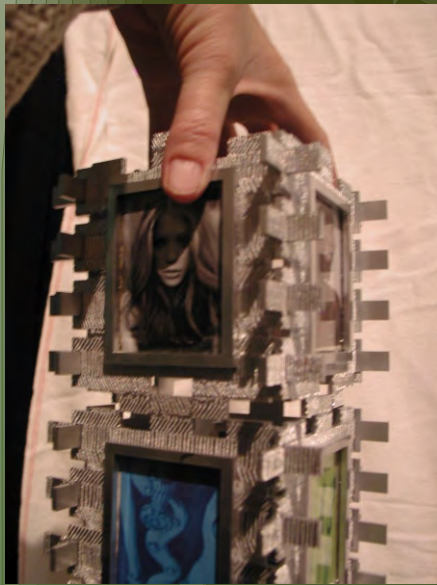


View from green side

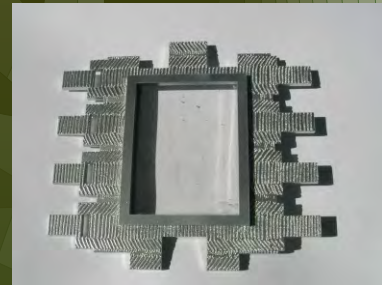
